** Feral cats: price includes surgery, injection of NSAID, rabies and FVRCP vaccine, ear tip.

It's crucial to understand that the validity of the blood work varies, typically ranging from 1 to 3 months, and this duration depends on the patient's age and the type of surgery they are undergoing.
